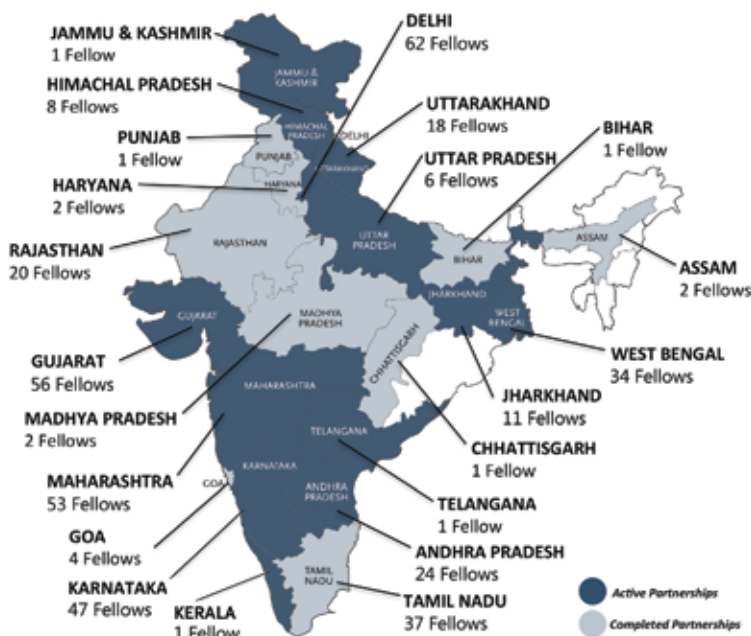

PROCESS & STRUCTURE

- **Application:** Three stage highly competitive application resulting in 7% admission rate.
- **Matching:** Rigorous process that ensures alignment of skill sets of incoming Fellows with needs of partner organizations.
- **Training:** Three programs at orientation, midpoint, and endpoint to inculcate professional knowledge and leadership skills.
- **Mentorship & Support:** On the ground monitoring of projects and ongoing mentorship and support to Fellows through professionally qualified AIF staff and partners.
- **Knowledge & Access:** Close connectivity to other AIF programs running on the ground.
